
Purpose: For attachment to postal packages of Australian Native Stingless Bees

1. Contents: This package contains (TICK box)

- $\hfill\square$ Live native stingless bees of genus Tetragonula or genus Austroplebeia
- $\hfill\square$ The bees are packaged with regard to ventilation for their well-being
- $\hfill\square$ The bees are packaged to limit their escape from the box

2. Information for postal staff:

- Australia Post allows the transport of bees, leeches and silkworms inside Australia. Packaging requirements are; Express Post, Separate Bag. Label requirement; 'separate bag'.
- Australian native stingless bees do not possess a sting and are unable to harm people.
- Do not refrigerate or freeze the package, Do not leave the box in direct sunlight, especially on hot days.
- Handle with care



3. Inspection Requirements:

Not Applicable. (Australian native stingless bees are not honey bees (*Apis mellifera*). Apiary inspection laws (state laws) relating to *Apis mellifera* for transport between states is not required for Australian native stingless bees.)

4. Relevant State Laws: (Disclaimer: It remains the responsibility of the sender to understand and comply with all applicable state and national legislation.)

SA, VIC, NT, QLD, NSW: At time of print there are no known state laws limiting transport of Australian native stingless bees between these states.

WA: The transport of Australian native stingless bees into WA from any other state is prohibited.
